

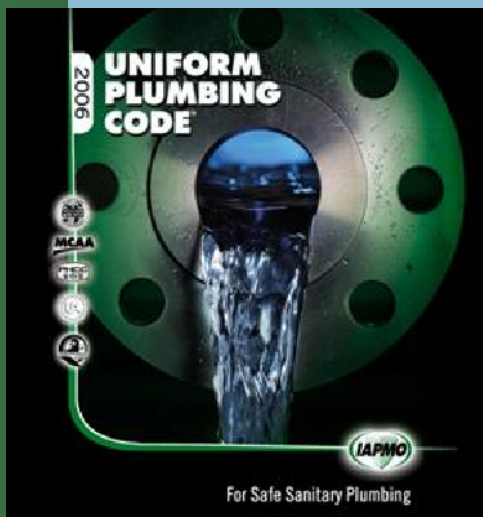
2006 UPC Plan Review, Installation and Inspection

DESCRIPTION:

This course will provide a comprehensive overview of the 2006 Uniform Plumbing Code on April 28th in Kirkland, Washington. Topics covered will include, but are not limited to, the general requirements, plumbing fixtures and fittings, water supply and distribution, and drain waste and vents.

THE SPEAKER:

Dave Cantrell is the Chief Plumbing Inspector for Public Health - Seattle & King County, serving as the code official for plumbing and fuel gas piping and supervises the plumbing and gas piping permit and inspection program for both jurisdictions. He is a Washington State certified journeyman plumber having been in the trade for 35 years, and has been involved in code administration and enforcement for the past 23 years. He has been an active participant in both the IAPMO and ICC code development processes nationally having served on a number of committees. Dave represents the Washington Association of Building Officials as a long time member of their Technical Code Development Committee and as their representative on the Plumbing Code Technical Advisory Group for the Washington State Building Code Council.
