



IMC/IFGC CODE UPDATES SEMINAR

COURSE DESCRIPTION.

This seminar is based on the 2009 International Mechanical Code and the 2009 International Fuel Gas Code as adopted and amended by the State of Washington. We will discuss the significant changes from the 2006 codes and the basic provisions for appliance installation, combustion air, venting, fuel gas piping, ducting, ventilation and exhaust. Participants will gain an understanding how these requirements apply to design, plan review and inspection.
