



CRITICAL AREAS TRAINING FOR PROFESSIONALS

The City of Bellevue Development Services Department is offering a four-hour training focused on Bellevue's Critical Areas Ordinance with in-depth discussion on the six types of regulated critical areas, their functions and values along with multiple development and permitting scenarios.

The training session is designed for professional service providers, such as architects, engineers, surveyors, and environmental consultants, who want to be more desirable and effective at documenting, designing and permitting projects on sites in Bellevue requiring critical areas review. Participants will gain knowledge and tools to save their clients' time and money.

Attendees will receive a copy of the presentation materials, a set of critical areas information handouts and a tabbed reference copy of the critical areas ordinance, as well as the City's Critical Areas Handbook on CD.
