NFPA Fire Sprinkler Update Seminar

Based on the 2009 International Codes

DESCRIPTION

This course will cover the basic requirements of the Standards for the Installation of Sprinkler Systems (NFPA 13, 13D, & 13R) and when and where required as specified in the 2009 International Codes, including the new requirements for one- and two-family dwellings as specified in the IRC. The seminar will touch on the systems components, hardware, installation requirements, and design approaches.

Stephen has worked for the City of Bellevue's Fire Department as a Fire Prevention Officer for the past 10 years performing fire inspections, investigations and plan review. Mr. Sexton is an ICC Certified Fire Inspector II and has presented training for Fire Prevention Officers and taught at Bellevue's Fire Academy. His prior employment ranges from designing fire suppression systems for the Boeing 747 and under pier sprinklers to designing sprinkler systems in commercial buildings.
